## Choo-Choose to have some train fun with us

In this exciting flight of activities preschoolers and adults can have some fun without going *off the rails*. All activities are minds-on with a focus on those fun locomotives that move us still today.

For this age-group there is no specific curriculum addressed, these programs are great for all learners, just adjust the activities to suit and have fun!

### Activity Four: Trains Take Shape

#### *What you need:*

Shapes – create your own with paper, construction paper, paper with colour or print out ‘Trains Take Shape’ worksheet. Colour and cut out.

#### *Instructions:*

Simply create a train using geometric shapes.

Ask your learner to create a train. They can choose to make just the engine, engine with cars or just a train car. Whatever they like; the goal is to be able to name the shapes they used when they are done.

Following the activity, you can look online for some other images of trains and engage your learner with what you find. How different do new trains look to older ones? Does its natural environment shape the train?
