

**THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF GREY  
BY-LAW 4645-10  
A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 3332-92 BEING A BY-LAW THAT  
PROVIDES FOR THE CONTROL OF WOLVES AND COYOTES**

WHEREAS the Minister of Natural Resources, pursuant to Section 17 of the Game and Fish Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter G.1 may, and has authorized certain municipal corporations, under certain conditions to provide compensation for the control of wolves and coyotes;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the County of Grey, may pursuant to Section 9 of The Municipal Act, 2010, as amended, pass by-laws to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the County of Grey deems it desirable to enact such regulations to provide for valuable consideration, for the control of wolves and coyotes in order to maintain and enhance the safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Grey;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY OF GREY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Clause 2 (f) of By-Law 3332-92 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The designated person(s) of the local municipality in which the trapping occurs shall be presented with the ears of the carcass as verification and shall destroy the ears after certification has occurred”

2. This By-Law shall come into force and effect on March 2, 2010.
