

Tom and Karen Ferri have over 58,000 super spindle apple trees on 22 acres of land near Clarksburg. The Ferri’s have earned a reputation for their large premium apples, their welcoming retail market and their love of the Georgian Bay lifestyle.

The Ferri farming legacy began when Tom’s grandfather bought 10 acres in Huttonville in 1933. The family farmed through the war and the depression to build a booming retail and wholesale business. As urban development grew closer to the farm, the family decided to sell.

From a family of innovators, Tom chose a super spindle crop. “It’s expensive to plant but you get into production quickly. I’d never grow a tree another way” explains Tom. “We sell Honey Crisp, Mac, Mutsu, Ambrosia, Gala, Cortland, Golden Delicious and our exclusive Bay Beauty. People say they’ve never tasted fruit like this before,” says Karen who’s been steadily building their retail business.
