Very muddy yesterday & today I was darning & mending this forenoon. Wrote to Henry Trout this afternoon Jones started in Topic class. Subject Eating of meats. Brown biscuit for supper.

Washing out early - James down town for potatoes - Rold wheat. Doctor at Armstrongs baby born at 4 o'clock she took chloroform last two hours. I heard the news at meeting from Fanny Bell. Bro Harding did most all speaking on confessing sin and praying forgiveness

A big thunderstorm last night. and raining most all day towards night there was enough snow to make the boards white. I paid Bro McCarlin \$1.10 for flour. He did ironing & wrote some & Abbie went to all the classes.

This is Good Friday I went to all classes as usual coughing away most as hard as ever. I have been at it eleven days. Bro Elam called went with us to Topic class then went to his sisters for tea. We all went to Lord's home light views of Australia bc I was sick and coughing. Will & Emily did not go

SAT. APRIL 1, 1899

Wea.

I did sweeping then went with James to Jewish Tabernacle was there from 10 to 11:30 beautiful flowers for Easter in shops I was at singing class but not Lipscomb. No Bible class Jones out to Riggs cross-roads, the folks all down for a sing.

SUNDAY 2

Wea.
