**Housing** Staff of Grey County Housing are available to speak with tenants regarding their tenancy, field complaints, complete required paperwork and connect tenants to community resources. There will also be a calendar for the Housing Office – Doris's old space to speak with housing about concerns.

**ODSP** – On site twice a month to speak to people About any Ontario Disability Support Questions.

**OW** An Ontario Works Caseworker is available to meet with tenants in receipt of Social Assistance or to discuss eligibility for Social Services Income Support or other financial assistance.

**ALC** – Adult learning center, please come by if you Are interested in obtaining upgrades or looking to get Your GED (Highschool diploma)

### **Good Food Box Program**

Pre-order by: Second Tuesday of the month when Housing Staff are present- then you Pick up your box at Unit 3 on the third Wednesday of the month from Unit 3 between 2:30-3:30

The Good Food Box program makes purchasing vegetables and fruit easy and affordable for everyone in the community.

The box contains 10-15 different types of fresh fruits and vegetables each month. The produce included will vary by season. It operates September-June each year.

The cost \$12/box. Subsidy is available for eligible participants. If interested please fill in an NCB application at the center- with subsidy the box is \$5.

All tenants are welcome to drop by the center when it's open. We, a food pantry, clothing, a play area for small children and free resources.
