Status: Recommendation adopted by Committee as presented per Resolution CW-60-17; Endorsed by County Council April 27, 2017 per Resolution CC19-17;

Recommendation

1. That Report TR-CW-13-17 regarding tender award recommendations for RFT-TS-02-17 be received and that the tender be awarded to E.C. King Construction for \$1,473,926.51 excluding taxes; and
2. That a 5% construction contingency be added to the tender price resulting in a revised estimated cost of \$1,574,861.00 net HST.

Background

The parameters for the tender are as follows:

- Tender consists of road rehabilitation and will be awarded to the lowest total bid.

The tender was posted on the Grey County website from March 2, 2017 until March 21, 2017. The bids received are shown below.

It is recommended to award RFT-TS-02-17 to E.C. King Contracting in the amount of \$1,473,926.51, excluding taxes.

This project does not require the standard 10% construction contingency due to the fact that it is not as complex as most. Therefore, a 5% construction contingency was deemed reasonable and is slated to compensate for any unforeseen quantity overruns and possible fluctuations in the Asphalt Cement Price Index.

The project deficit will be funded from the current surplus available from the 2017 capital construction budget.
